Yearly Report of North American Humanitarian Aid & Relief (NAHAR) Year: 2023



North American Humanitarian Aid & Relief (NAHAR) has been dedicated to its mission since its establishment in 2011. Over the years, the organization has expanded its reach to provide vital assistance in more than 30 countries spanning four continents. NAHAR's efforts are primarily concentrated on three critical areas: emergency response, economic development, and the sponsorship of orphans. The year 2023 presented an increased number of emergencies, challenging the organization to act quickly and efficiently. Despite these heightened demands, NAHAR remained steadfast in its commitment to its ongoing support initiatives around the globe, ensuring that aid and relief continued to reach those in need.

Emergency Responses Around the World in 2023

Throughout 2023, North American Humanitarian Aid & Relief (NAHAR) was at the forefront of responding to numerous global emergencies. From the Gaza crisis to catastrophic floods in Bangladesh, NAHAR's immediate response included the provision of essential aid such as food, water, and medical supplies to affected populations.

Since 2018, NAHAR has been actively assisting the war-torn population in Gaza through both short-term relief and long-term development projects. When a massive attack occurred in late 2023, the organization swiftly provided emergency supplies, benefiting around 3,000 people. Similarly, in Turkey, following a devastating earthquake that claimed over fifty thousand lives, NAHAR launched immediate relief efforts. From the very first day, the organization delivered food, water, and essential supplies. A team of 50 trained volunteers and staff from Muntada AID, along with 20 doctors and nurses, provided critical medical support to those in need.

In the aftermath of the Turkish earthquake, NAHAR initiated several projects to assist the victims, collaborating with the local organization 'Hayrat Yardim.' These projects included sponsorship for 500 orphaned children and extended aid to over 10,000 individuals. NAHAR's commitment to relief efforts was further demonstrated by their response to other crises, such as the earthquakes in Morocco and Syria, the floods in Libya and Bangladesh, and the fire in the Rohingya refugee camp. Through these initiatives, the organization provided vital assistance to approximately 15,000 people.

NAHAR's extensive efforts were made possible through collaboration with various international partners, ensuring the timely and efficient implementation of relief projects. Furthermore, during the holy month of Ramadan, NAHAR conducted a global food distribution campaign, significantly alleviating hunger and providing sustenance to numerous impoverished communities around the world. This comprehensive approach underscores NAHAR's unwavering dedication to humanitarian aid and its ability to mobilize resources and expertise in response to emergencies worldwide.

E;p[o.ach food pack is carefully prepared to include a variety of essential food items and a sufficient supply of water, designed to sustain a family for the entire month of Ramadan. This thoughtful provision of resources not only addresses immediate nutritional needs but also alleviates the economic burden on families during this significant period.

The impact of NAHAR's 2023 Ramadan food pack distribution was profound, reaching approximately 18,000 people worldwide. This effort was not limited to providing sustenance; it was a demonstration of solidarity and support for communities facing hardships. By ensuring that families had enough to eat, NAHAR helped create an environment where the spiritual and communal aspects of Ramadan could be fully embraced.

Beyond the food packs, NAHAR extended its humanitarian efforts through Eid gift distributions and Fitrah projects. These initiatives played a crucial role in facilitating joyful and peaceful Eid UI Fitr celebrations. Eid gifts, often comprising clothing, toys, and sweets, were distributed to children and families, bringing smiles and a sense of festivity to those who might otherwise have had little to celebrate. The Fitrah projects, which involve the distribution of obligatory alms given before the end of Ramadan, further reinforced the communal bonds and supported those in dire need.

Through these comprehensive efforts, NAHAR not only addressed immediate hunger but also fostered a sense of community and hope among the recipients. The Ramadan food pack distribution, coupled with the Eid gift and Fitrah initiatives, underscores NAHAR's commitment to holistic humanitarian aid, ensuring that the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of vulnerable populations are met during one of the most important times of the year.





Global Qurbani Meat Distribution





The global Udhiya/Qurbani program by North American Humanitarian Aid & Relief (NAHAR) represents a significant effort to support underprivileged communities during the sacred celebration of Eid-Ul-Adha. In 2023, this impactful program was implemented in more than 20 countries worldwide, encompassing regions that face severe economic challenges and food insecurity. Among the countries where the program was active were Benin, Chad, Ghana, Mali, Niger, Uganda, and Bangladesh. These regions were carefully selected based on the pressing needs of their populations and the potential for NAHAR's intervention to make a meaningful difference.

The Qurbani, or sacrifice, is a vital part of Eid-Ul-Adha, symbolizing devotion, charity, and the sharing of blessings. NAHAR's Qurbani program provided a way for needy individuals and families to partake in this important religious tradition, which they might otherwise have been unable to afford. By facilitating the sacrifice of livestock and the distribution of meat, NAHAR ensured that over 7,000 needy people around the world could celebrate Eid-Ul-Adha with dignity and joy.

Each Qurbani was conducted in accordance with Islamic principles, ensuring that the process respected the cultural and religious practices of the communities served. The meat from the sacrifices was distributed to the most vulnerable segments of the population, including orphans, widows, and the elderly. This act of giving not only addressed immediate nutritional needs but also fostered a sense of inclusion and community among the recipients.

Moreover, NAHAR's Qurbani program went beyond mere distribution. It involved meticulous planning and coordination with local partners and volunteers to ensure the timely and efficient delivery of aid. In countries like Uganda and Bangladesh, for instance, NAHAR worked closely with local organizations to identify the most needy families and to organize community events where the meat could be distributed in a fair and respectful manner.

The impact of the Qurbani program was profound. For many, receiving the meat meant not just a meal but an opportunity to celebrate Eid-Ul-Adha with their families, participate in communal feasts, and uphold their religious traditions. Projects for Rohingya Refugees in Bangladesh

For the past few years, Rohingya refugees have resided in Bangladesh, facing numerous challenges as they seek safety and stability. In response, North American Humanitarian Aid & Relief (NAHAR) has consistently provided vital support through a range of impactful projects. 


